Impact to AED Communities

To responders, nothing will change and there will be no additional work for coordinators.

The internal improvements to the alerting system will provide a more reliable and stable alerting system.

CARDIAC ARRESTS

- By December 31, ReadyAlert will have a Master Alert Database of all AED Communities, their street names and house numbers. The accuracy of this database will have been confirmed by each coordinator.

CARDIAC ARREST ALERTS

Cardiac arrests notifications sent by 911 Dispatch will instantly use this list to identify the AED community, the street name and house number. An alert will be sent to the Community responders.

CARDIAC ARREST ALERTS

For AED Communities in the system prior to January 1, 2017, there will be parallel alerting between 911 Dispatch and ReadyAlert for the near future.

There will be two cardiac arrest alerts sent to responders.

MONTHLY TEST ALERT

Groups will maintain current frequency – the days may change.

Beginning in January, 2017, the testing schedule is as follows:

MONTHLY TEST ALERT

- Groups now being tested every **14 days**, will continue receiving a test alert every 14 days starting on Monday, January 2nd, 2017.

MONTHLY TEST ALERT

- Groups now being tested **once a month**, will receive a test alert on the 1st Wednesday of each month starting January 4, 2017

MONTHLY TEST ALERT

Test alerts will come from
ReadyAlert, not Rural
Metro or Marion County


CARDIAC ARREST DRILL

Twice a year a cardiac arrest test alert will be sent to all AED Communities using the coordinator's address. ReadyAlert will notify coordinators one month prior to the date of the test. Opt-out available.

ACCESSING YOUR ACCOUNT

When you view your account, you will now see a total number of responders, how many are suspended (red), how many responder households (paid) and the renewal month of your group.

EXAMPLE

Enisgrove Mayflower has 33 responders, 8 are suspended, 19 paid responder households, 5 Alternates and will be invoiced in October.
